

MERIT BADGE SELECTION

Circle your Merit Badge choices directly on the Merit Badge/Program Schedule Table (next page). Notice that there are 5 Sessions to sign up for Merit Badges at Camp Skymont. Some Merit Badges require two periods so look at the table carefully before you circle your choice.

Return your choices by March 1st. Obtain approval from a Scout Master for your selection and return to M Hockenberry. The Scout Master's initials should be beside your name on the table.

Merit Badge registration opens March 1st at Camp Skymont and returning it on time gives you a better chance for obtaining your Merit Badge choices. If you do not receive your first choices we will be in touch.
