Please continue to support Boy Scout Troop 870 in proudly displaying our American flag along the streets of Pine Brook.

Boy Scout Troop 870 will once again be placing the handsome 3'x5' American flags, mounted on a 10' galvanized steel pole, curbside in your front yard during four patriotic holidays throughout the year:

Memorial Day, May 30th

Independence Day, July 4th

Patriots Day, September 11th

Veterans Day, November 11th

The flags will be installed in advance of the holiday, and fly for several days during each holiday period.

The Flag Code states “when a patriotic effect is desired, the flag may be displayed 24 hours a day if properly illuminated during the hours of darkness”. Direct lighting is not required. Streets lights provide the indirect lighting to help us show our respect for the flag by enabling us to always see the flag when it is flying.
